

Making a PowerPoint Aquarium

Using PowerPoint:

Make an Aquarium using animated gif and ppt animations.

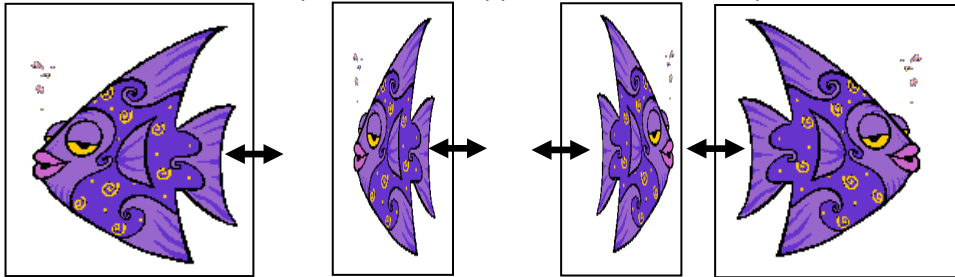
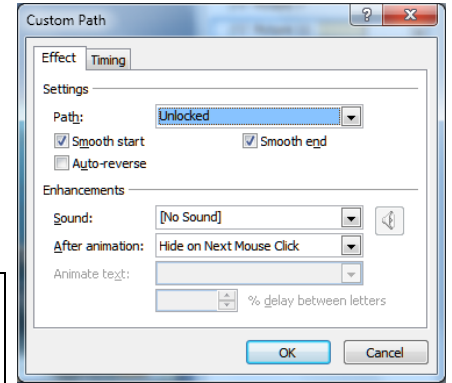
Use Blank slide layout

Use the internet to find an underwater background (w/o fish—maybe search for coral reef) and animated fish and seaweed etc. (or go to <http://danb80.com/fishes>)

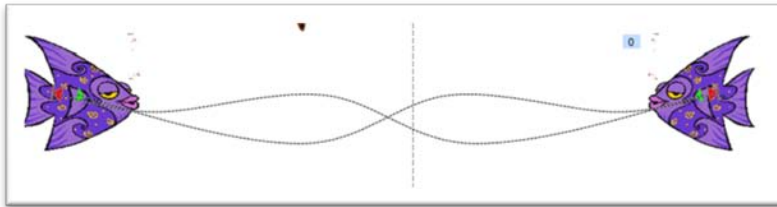
Use motion paths (custom animation) for the fish, vary the path length and speed for the different fish, have start "After Previous"

To get the fish to swim back,

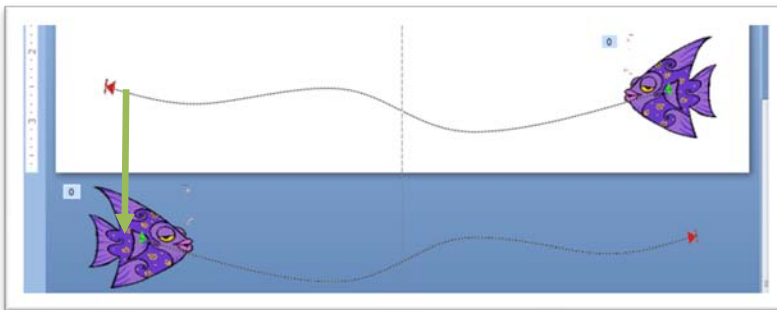
- on effect options, under After animation, Hide on Next Mouse Click
- Copy the picture
- Click on the new picture. On the box surrounding the picture, there is a circle in the middle of the side. Click on it and drag it across the picture to the opposite to reverse the picture.



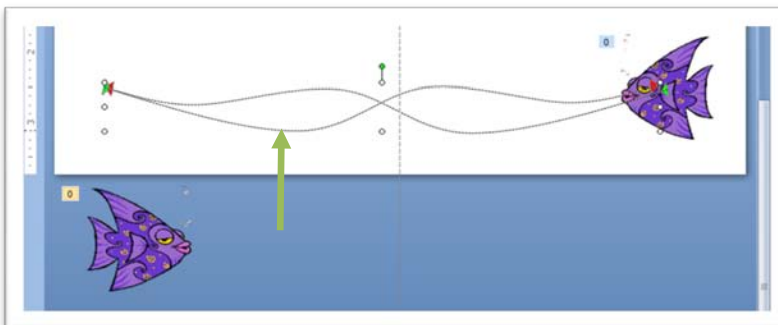
- Create a path for the fish, ,



and drag the fish off the page



then drag ONLY the path back on the screen, have start "After Previous"



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When you have more than one fish, move the animation for all the first paths to the top and the return paths to the bottom. After the first fish, have all start "With Previous"

To show the timeline seen at the left, right click (or click on the arrow at the end of the row) on one of the items and select "Show Advanced Timeline"

Add in additional animated gifs that don't need movement paths.



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Click on Slide Show Tab, and Rehearse Timings to get it to run automatically

Still on the Slide Show Tab, select Set-up Slide Show and click "Loop continuously until 'Esc' "
