As of the 8th day of February, 2022, Independent School District No. 5, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has 5 General Obligation bond issue(s) outstanding:

- \$24,660,000 Combined Purpose Bonds of 2017, dated June 1, 2017 (\$6,165,000 outstanding in principal as of the 8th day of February, 2022);
- \$28,530,000 Combined Purpose Bonds of 2018, dated June 1, 2018 (\$14,530,000 outstanding in principal as of the 8th day of February, 2022);
- \$29,170,000 Combined Purpose Bonds of 2019, dated June 1, 2019 (\$21,900,000 outstanding in principal as of the 8th day of February, 2022);
- \$27,605,000 Combined Purpose Bonds of 2020, dated June 1, 2020 (\$27,605,000 outstanding in principal as of the 8th day of February, 2022); and
- \$31,520,000 Combined Purpose Bonds of 2021, dated June 1, 2021 (\$31,520,000 outstanding in principal as of the 8th day of February, 2022).

The School District has \$81,690,000 in unissued building bonds authorized at an election held on the 10th day of February 2015. These bonds will be used to complete the constructing, furnishing, equipping, and/or acquiring of classrooms at the Elementary level, new classrooms at the Intermediate level, improvements for a central cafeteria expansion and remodel, renovations at the High School Buildings, and parking lot improvements and expansion at East Elementary.
